



Public Safety Scuba Instructor Recertification

Active PSSI: a PSSI in good standing who has instructed one or more PSD or PSD crossover programs within the last three years.

Required Documentation:

- Completed Recertification Workbook
- Copy of current DRI Specialist or DRIT certification
- Signed copy of Public Safety Diver Training Standards
- Signed copy of the Public Safety Scuba Instructor Agreement
- Photocopy of 18 departmental dives which can include operational, open water training or up to six pool dives.
- A current Medical History Form, signed by a physician
- Proof of current CPR & First Aid Training
- Completed Annual SCUBA Skills and IADRS Watermanship Test forms.
- Training System Agreement
- Signed and initialed copy of the Statement of Understanding and Liability Release and Express Assumption of Risk
- Letter of department sponsorship/insurance coverage (see sample letter)
- If you would like a new ID card, please submit 2 passport or ID photographs. Digital photos are accepted.

Due Date:

Recertification's must be **complete and received at headquarters** prior to the end of the certification period. All of the above documentation must be received to process your recertification.

Expired PSSI: a PSSI who has allowed three years to elapse since recertification or has not instructed at least one PSD or PSD crossover within the last three years. To be reinstated as an Active PSSI, you must attend and complete a PSSI program and submit the required documentation. The cost of attending another PSSI program is ½ the cost of normal tuition.
