



Ice Rescue Trainer

Hosted by Holland Fire Department
Holland, MI ~ January 25-27, 2019

This course is unlike any other ice rescue program. When you successfully complete an Ice Rescue Trainer course, you will go home with an Ice Rescue Training System for your agency. You will be able to instruct other public safety professionals within your department. This program is presented and managed through a cooperative effort between your department and Dive Rescue International. Your department is assured control over its investment while ensuring high quality training.

The Ice Rescue Training System contains our Ice Rescue Trainer Manual and associated audio-visual materials. The student kits include the Ice Rescue text and workbook, student final exam, Ice Rescue patch, and a Certificate of Training.

DAY ONE

Trainer candidates will review the course content presented during the one-day Ice Rescue program. Emphasis will be placed on: teaching the adult learner, preparation and effective presentation of the Ice Rescue program, discussion of effective testing and evaluation of students, in-depth discussions of course content including: ice formations and strength, victim's condition, ice rescue techniques and equipment.

TUITION

Full tuition for this 3 day program is \$425 in US Funds. Payment is required at the time of registration.

DAY TWO

Students will participate in eight hours of field exercises with emphasis on: practical evaluation of local ice conditions, knots and rigging, reach, throw, and go techniques. Finally, trainer candidates will demonstrate and evaluate practical skills within work groups.

DAY THREE

Trainer candidates will present assigned lecture topics from the Ice Rescue class material. Other topics covered: class review, final examination, award certificates of completion, distribution of AV materials.

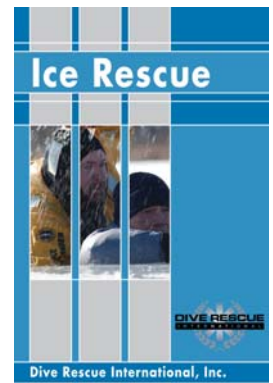


Prerequisites

All students must be a member of a public safety agency, at least 21 years of age and must provide proof of current CPR and First Aid training. A departmental sponsorship letter is required to complete the application process. *A sample sponsorship letter is provided in the Ice Rescue Trainer Application.*

Your application must be completed and returned with payment information to Dive Rescue International. The application is **NOT** a confirmation of registration. You will be notified of your official registration once your application is accepted and your registration fee is received.

This program is designed for personnel who are physically fit. Participants are encouraged to participate after successfully completing the IADRS Watermanship Test or testing to a fitness level of 13 MET (Metabolic Equivalents) or greater. Participants with aerobic fitness questions or concerns should consult their physician prior to in-water training. Participants who have poor aerobic fitness may attend this program as surface support personnel with the approval of the instructor.



Cancellation Policy

Cancellations received prior to 3 weeks before the start date of the class will receive a full refund. Cancellations received 8-21 days prior to class start date will receive a 50% refund. Cancellations received 0-7 days prior to class start date will not receive a refund.
