OBJECTIVE • An in-depth study of preventative and on-site care for injured divers. Recently re-designed and updated by Dr. Richard Sadler, Dive Rescue International's Staff Physician, this course material can be used by any responder including non-medical personnel.

JUSTIFICATION • Decompression emergencies are a very real possibility in the realm of public safety diving. This course helps ready agency personnel to face these challenges. This training is a prerequisite for most dive rescue trainer classes.
